One-Week Program: A Typical Day

The one-week skills intensive is a series of workshops introducing participants to the fundamentals of devised theatre based on improvisation. Each day is split into an AM and PM block, which is mostly devoted to one or two core areas of training or work. This model provides an introductory exposure to ensemble theatre creation and performance through a series of intensive acting workshops on voice, movement, chorus, music, and song. The program culminates with a workshop on the fifth day, where participants will create a fully devised piece of theatre based on a new text they receive that morning. Using their acquired skills, participants will go through the process of improvisation, creation, evaluation, and revision, at the end of which, they will present theatrical pieces for each other.
